Complete Color Palette

Capricorn Core

Charcoal Grey (#2C2C2C) • Slate (#404040) • Black (#1A1A1A) • Deep Brown (#3E2723)

Purpose: Traditional Saturn/Capricorn correspondences evoke discipline, grounding and long-term focus.

Best for: Altar base, career work, stability rituals, grounding practices

Summer-Earth Energy

Forest Green (#1B5E20) • Moss (#2E7D32) • Rich Soil Brown (#5D4037)

Purpose: Mirror the earth element, mid-summer foliage and the buck's velvet antlers—symbolising steady growth and strength.

Best for: Growth work, earth connection, prosperity rituals, nature-based practices

Buck-Moon Glow

Honey-Gold (#FFB300) • Warm Amber (#FF8F00) • Soft Wheat (#F57F17)

Purpose: The July Moon often rises with a golden hue and is linked to hay-making, mead and ripening grain. Gold candles are widely used in Buck-Moon rites for fulfilment and personal power.

Best for: Manifestation, personal power, abundance work, solar-plexus activation

Thunder-Moon Mood

Steel Blue-Grey (#37474F) • Storm-Cloud Navy (#263238)

Purpose: Nods to the "Thunder Moon" name and the dramatic summer storms common in July, adding a cleansing, electric charge.

Best for: Energy cleansing, banishing, transformation, storm magic

Guru Purnima Spirit

Pure White (#FFFFFF) • Soft Lotus Pink (#FCE4EC) • Saffron Orange (#FF9800)

Purpose: White and saffron are worn in Guru Purnima ceremonies to honour teachers, symbolising purity, enlightenment and devotion. Lotus-pink accents echo spiritual awakening.

Best for: Spiritual practice, gratitude work, teacher honoring, meditation

Intention Boosters

Deep Green (#1B5E20) • Rose/Red (#C2185B)

Purpose: Capricorn workings often add colour by goal: green for money, rose/red for passion.

Best for: Prosperity work, love rituals, focused intentions, goal-specific magic

Quick Color Guide by Intention

Stability & Career

Colors: Charcoal grey + deep brown

Perfect for: Long-term planning, career decisions, building foundations

Prosperity Work

Colors: Forest green + gold accent

Perfect for: Financial abundance, business growth, material success

Love & Relationships

Colors: Rose-red on grey cloth

Perfect for: Attracting love, healing relationships, emotional balance

Spiritual Gratitude

Colors: Pure white with saffron/pink

Perfect for: Teacher appreciation, spiritual growth, divine connection

Energy Cleanse

Colors: Steel blue-grey + white

Perfect for: Releasing negativity, fresh starts, mental clarity

Personal Power

Colors: Honey-gold + amber

Perfect for: Confidence building, manifestation, solar-plexus work



Practical Application Guide

Creating Your Sacred Buck Moon Space

- **Altar Base:** Lay an earthy charcoal or brown cloth as foundation (Capricorn grounding energy)
- **Central Focus:** Place a gold or honey-yellow pillar candle to represent Buck Moon glow and midsummer abundance
- **Natural Elements:** Ring with evergreen sprigs (pine, cedar, rosemary) to anchor earth energy and longevity
- **Sacred Touch:** Add small white cloth or lotus-pink flower as nod to Guru Purnima gratitude
- **Crystal Support:** Clear quartz for amplification, tiger's-eye for discipline, green aventurine for prosperity

Candle Magic & Color Combinations

- **Career Focus:** Grey or black pillar candle with deep brown base cloth
- **Money Manifestation:** Gold center candle surrounded by green tea lights
- **Love Attraction:** Rose or red candle on charcoal grey altar cloth
- **Spiritual Growth:** White candle with saffron orange accents
- **Energy Clearing:** Steel blue-grey candle with white purification stones

Clothing & Personal Practice

- **Earth Work:** Wear brown, grey, or forest green for grounding and stability rituals
- **Spiritual Practice:** Choose white, saffron, or soft pink for meditation and gratitude work
- **Empowerment:** Drape gold, amber, or honey-colored shawl for confidence and manifestation
- **Cleansing:** Blue-grey or navy clothing for transformation and banishing work

Buck Moon Timing & Traditions

Peak Full Moon: When the full moon occurs in Capricorn

Optimal Practice Window: 3 days before and after the full moon

Best Practice Times: Dawn, dusk, or during moonrise

Traditional Names: Buck Moon, Thunder Moon, Hay Moon, Guru Purnima

Cultural Significance: Time of antler growth, summer storms, spiritual teacher honoring

Capricorn Themes: Structure, ambition, long-term goals, mountain-climbing energy
